Meeting Roles

Toastmaster: guides the overall meeting

Topics Master: leads the Table Topics session

Speakers: give Prepared Speeches

General Evaluator: leads the Evaluation section

Speech Evaluators: give feedback on Prepared Speeches

Ah Counter: reports on use of filler words

Grammarians: selects Word of the Day and reports on use of English language

Timer: signals timing throughout meeting and reports times

TIP: Ah Counter, Timer and Grammarian are great first roles for a new Toastmaster

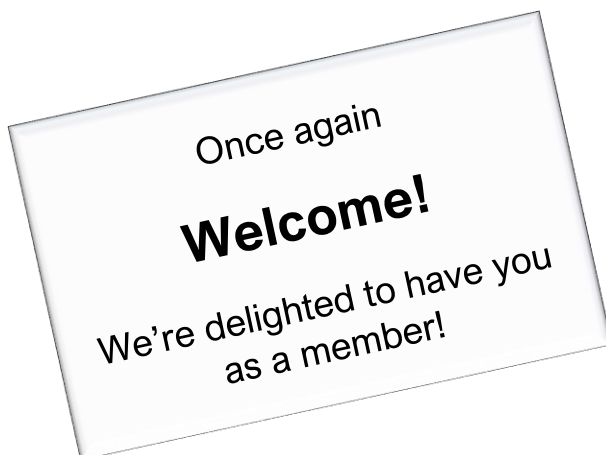
TIP: Aim to deliver your Ice Breaker in your first 4-6 weeks of joining!
